In numeracy this week we have been looking at calculating the area and perimeter of shapes that are made up from rectangles.

Your homework uses the skills you have learnt throughout the week.

You can use a calculator to help with multiplying decimals but you must show *how* you have calculated the answer.

Remember area is measured in units<sup>2</sup> and perimeter in just the units.

Notes for helpers

Area of rectangles is calculated by multiplying the length by the breadth (or width).

Perimeter is calculated by adding up all of the sides.

The children may need to split the shape into 2 or more rectangles to answer the questions but should be able to do this as we have been working on this all week.
